Dr Tan is registered as a Family Physician from 2012. Dr Tan is involved in many aspects of Eldercare work; in the development and piloting of new elder friendly technologies and products, long-term care services, training of caregivers, and consulting on care homes architecture among others. He is currently running clinical practices in private home care services, an outreach clinic and locuming for a geriatric

department in a public hospital.

Dr Chong Keng Hua is an Assistant Professor of Architecture and Sustainable Design at the Singapore University of Technology and Design (SUTD), where he leads the Social Urban Research Groupe (SURGe). He is also the co-founder of COLOURS: Collectively Ours LLP, an award-winning design consultancy specializing in collaborative public place design. He was appointed as curator for Singapore Pavilion at the Venice Biennale International Architecture Exhibition 2018, and member of Jurong Lake District Steering Committee in 2015-2017.
